- **Install Required Plugin**

`EasyOrder - B2B Plugin for WooCommerce` plugin is an extension of `WooCommerce` plugin. So before installing this plugin, please make sure you've installed the `WooCommerce` plugin. Otherwise this plugin will not work and you'll get warning message in WordPress admin area.

It is optional to install `Dokan` plugin, if you want to get multivendor support.

- Install EasyOrder - B2B Plugin for WooCommerce Plugin from WordPress Admin:

After download the full package from CodeCanyon, you will have `easy-order.zip` file inside your main package. You can install it from WordPress admin.

1. Go to wordpress Dashboard -> plugins -> add new.
2. From here click upload plugins button, then you will find the plugin upload window.
3. Upload easy-order.zip file from your computer then click install now button.
4. After successfully install the plugin then active it.

• # Admin Dashboard:

Form the admin dashboard add new product in **simple** product type you can find **Price Tiers** on the **General** tab after the product price section.

You can set a various range of price options for your product, as you wish to configure per your business to business requirements. Every quantity based pricing configuration you can click the **Add Tier** button and setup your minimum quantity and the final price for that min quantity.

- Fields on price tiers

- Minimum Quantity
- Final Price

Every quantity based price is valid until it finds another minimum quantity bigger than the current one.

For example you have set first tier minimum quantity is 50 and price is \$2, and then you have added another range 100 and \$1.90. So to understand how this pricing will work.

You can purchase \$2.7 for each quantity until it reaches minimum quantity is 50. In your cart for 50 bulk order of that product your price will dynamically change to \$2 for per item.

The next minimum tier is 100 and price is \$1.90. So your second price tier is working until your quantity is 50-99, after that for 100 to 499 your price will be \$1.90 on each product.

From 500-999 price will be calculated \$1.70 per item, and finally after 1000 items price will set to \$1.55.

In your product details pricing table will be displayed like the screenshot down below. If your customer meet the minimum quantity requirements then the price will dynamically calculated on the cart page and checkout page during order.

Dokan Dashboard:

EasyOrder - B2B Plugin for WooCommerce plugin also supports Dokan multivendor plugin, so all the vendor of the site can configure their B2B pricing plan from the Dokan vendor dashboard.

It's almost the same thing to configure the price tier settings, You can find it on dokan dashboard when you go to edit product from the frontend, you will see the same price tier settings button and minimum quantity and the price field to set that.

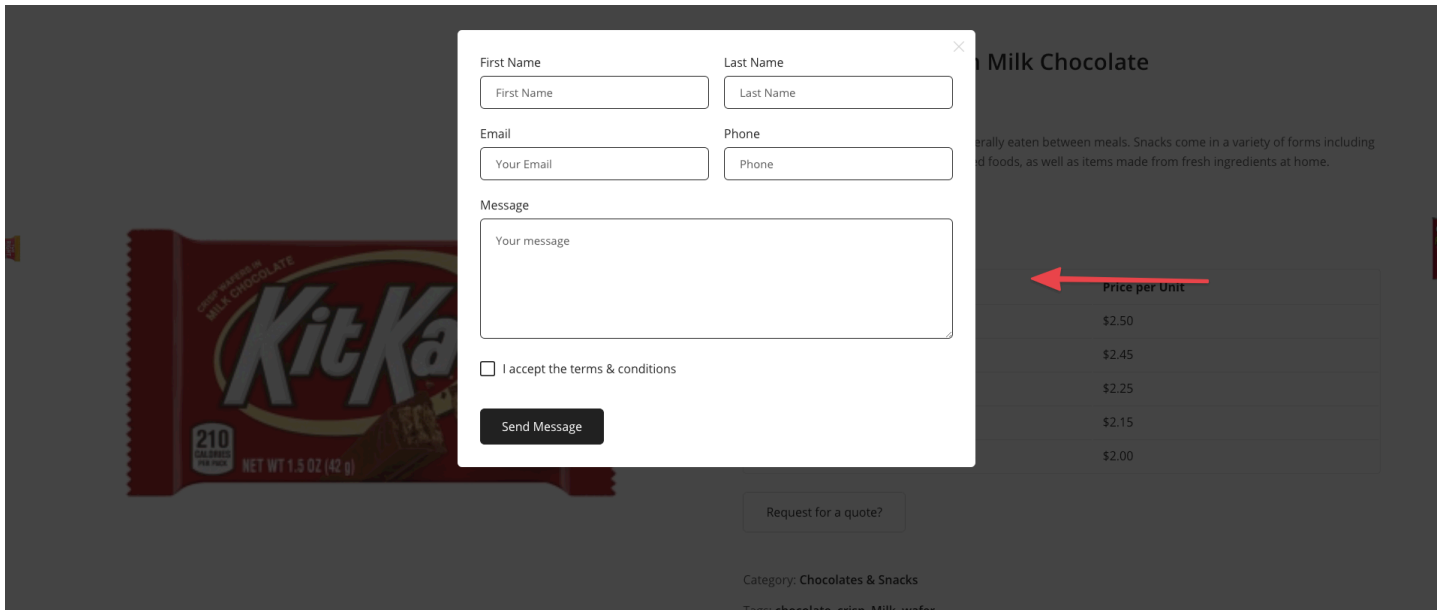

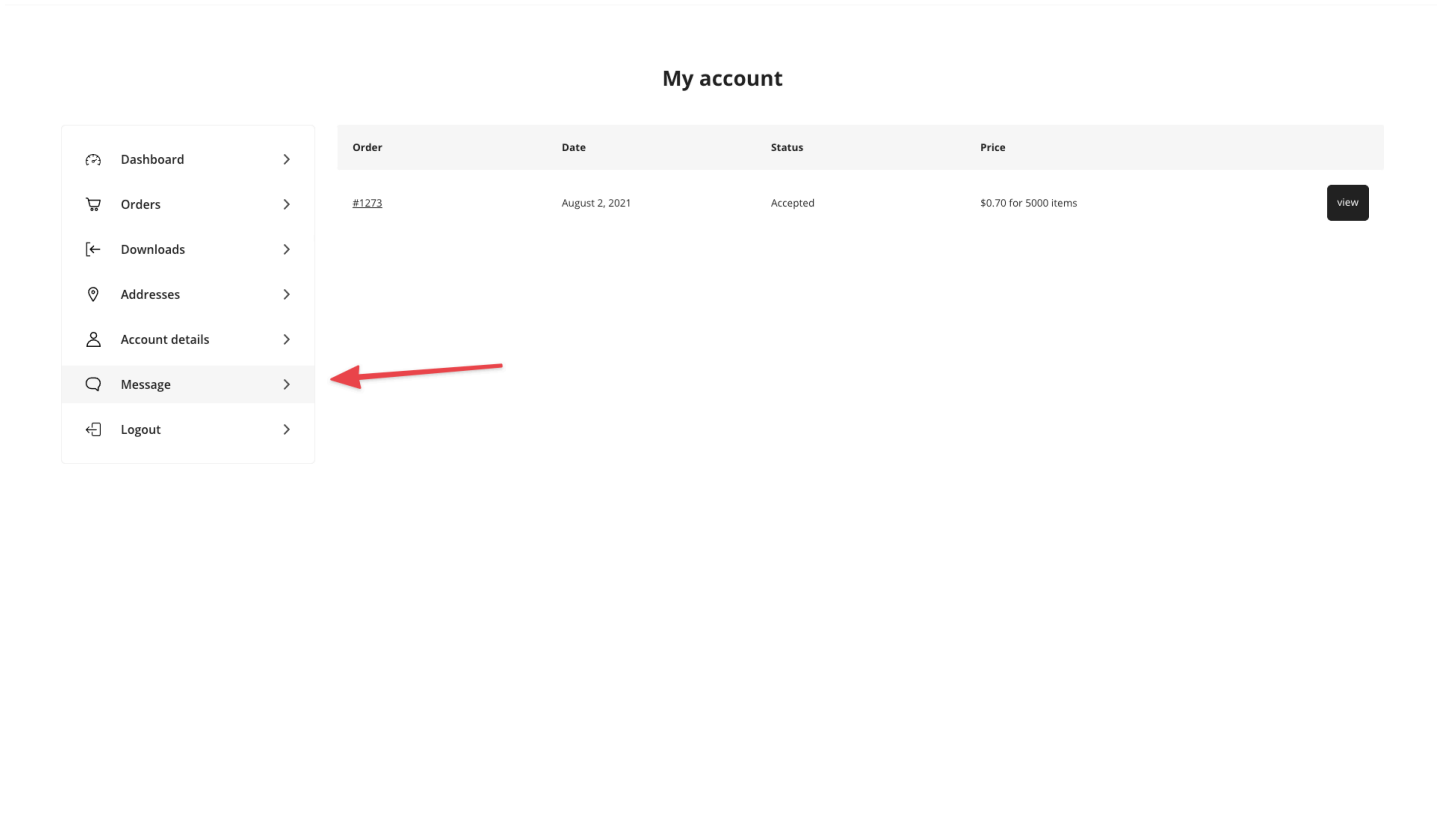

Your customer can send you custom message for getting customize price for any tier. All communication is private and the price will only work with the dedicated user.



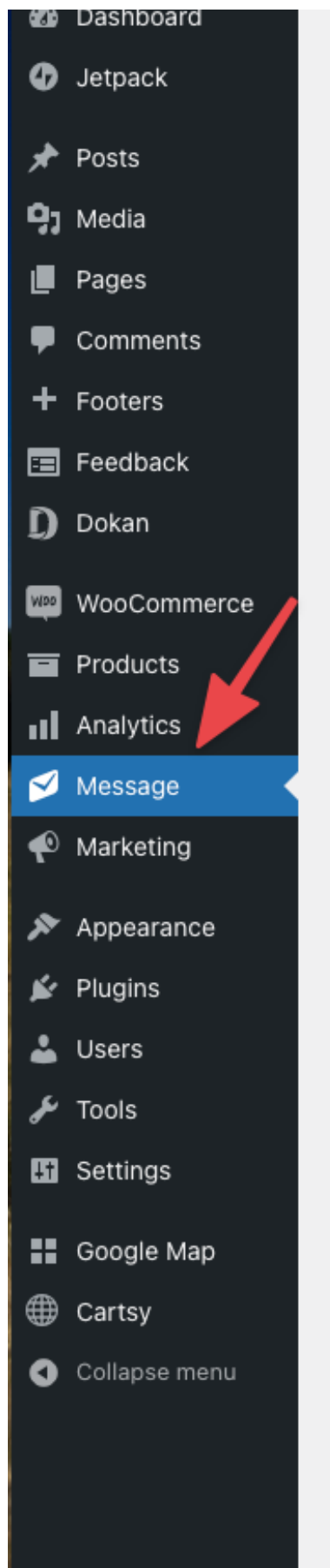
Both product owner and customer will get email notificatoion for the message between them. and in the my account section you user can see the details of their requests.



In your user my account there will be a menu message, they can keep track from there.

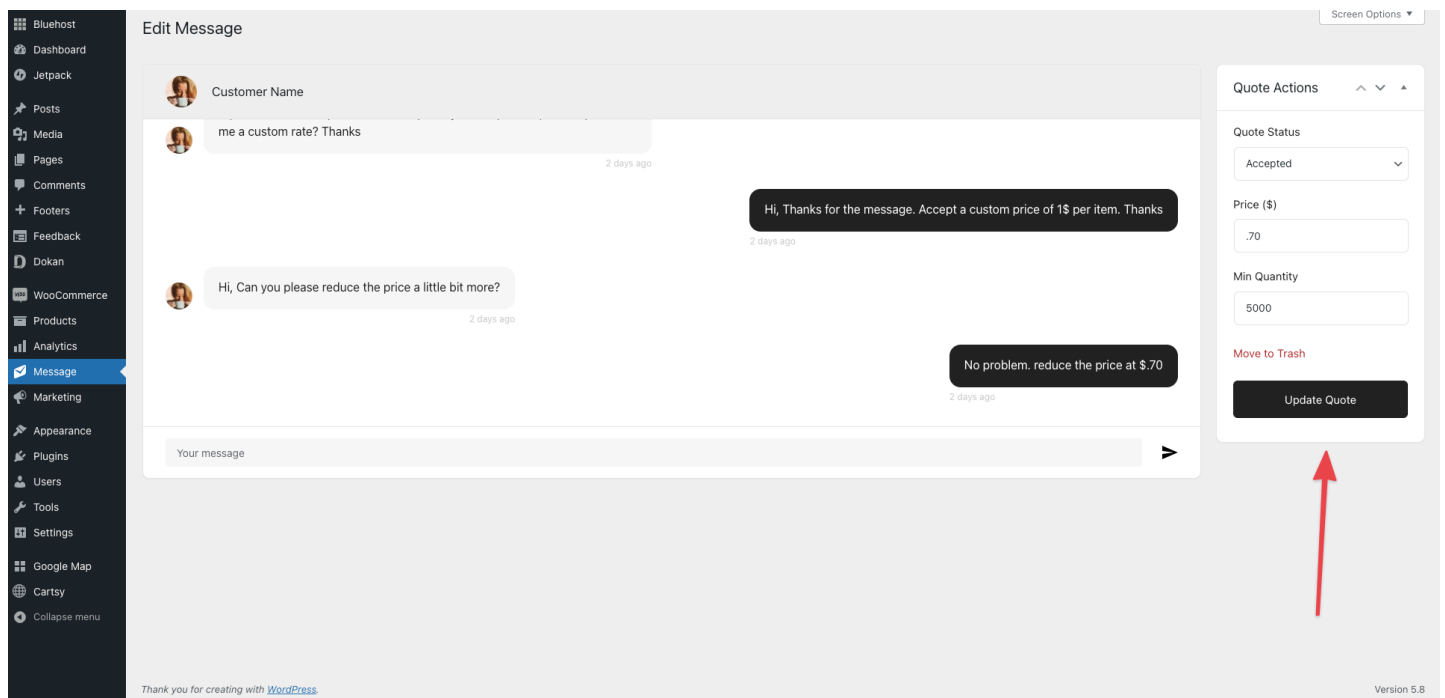
In the admin panel site owner can track it from
